#### **V. Background:**

Today's conflicts are at once deadlier, costlier and more protracted. Conflict dynamics are also becoming increasingly complex, so are their connections to other threats to peace and security. This couldn't be truer than in the case of Africa and the Arab world. The nature of conflict continues to drastically evolve, with interstate conflicts giving way to intrastate ones, which in turn had been spilling over international borders to challenge peace and security in other regions.

As a result, conflict prevention and resolution have been prioritized on the international peace and security agenda. Key Strategic international and regional frameworks emphasized the need for further investments in capacity building in areas such as early warning/early response, to prevent the escalation and recurrence of violent conflict in fragile contexts.

CCCCPA has been supported by UNDP projects funded by the Government of Japan, with the aim of strengthening its institutional capacity and providing various partners in the continent with trainings to build capacities in peacemaking and peacebuilding, to ensure they have the necessary skills and knowledge for appropriate and timely interventions to challenges and risks that threaten peace and stability.

#### **Deliverables:**

- Delivery of one training course on "Analytic Techniques".
- Preparation of all training material for the delivery of the aforementioned trainings, including, PowerPoint presentations, case studies and exercises.

#### **Work Experience and Education**

- University degree in international relations, international development, conflict and security or political science preferred.
- At least 10 years of experience in areas related to the output. Preference will be given to candidates whose experience include roles assumed in training institutions.
